

## 2024 Arch MI Data Dive Rules

- The Data Dive event runs from Friday, Nov. 1 (6–8 p.m.) through Saturday, Nov. 2 (9 a.m.–8:30 p.m.).
- Teams will consist of four to six members. Participants should register as individuals but can request to be placed on a team with fellow classmates. However, Arch MI will have the final decision on each student’s placement on a team and cannot guarantee students will be placed as requested.
- Prizes totaling \$6,000 (\$3,000 for first place, \$2,000 for second place, \$1,000 for third place) will be awarded. Prize winnings are subject to applicable taxes.
- Prizes are per team, not per individual, and will be divided evenly among the members of each winning team.
- Participants must complete an Arch MI W-9 form (enclosed) before prize money is awarded.
- All participants will be required to sign a liability release form upon arrival at Arch MI before the event starts.
- There is no registration fee, but transportation costs are the responsibility of each individual.
- Arch MI will provide lodging when requested. Those who are granted a hotel reservation must abide by the rules and regulations of the hotel facility. A credit card will be required at check-in solely for incidentals (room service, minibar, etc.), but room and tax charges only will be the responsibility of Arch MI. You will be responsible for any other charges.
- The dress code is business casual for the opening reception. Data Dive event t-shirts will be given to each participant to wear on Saturday. Jeans or chino-style pants and sneakers are permissible throughout the entire event.
- Participants must bring their own personal devices (laptops, tablets, etc.) for use during the event.
- Internet access will be made available via the Arch MI Guest network but solely for work related to the Data Dive event.
- Participants are permitted to use smartphones, mobile phones or other electronic devices during the competition to conduct research or computations.
- Team members are not allowed to leave Arch MI Corporate Headquarters during the competition.
- If a participant leaves Arch MI Corporate Headquarters during the competition, they will not be permitted to return and continue the competition.
- Participants are not allowed to receive help from anyone other than members of their team or the Arch MI employee assigned to each team. Teams will be disqualified if found in violation of any of these rules.
- At the competition’s conclusion, each team will have approximately 10–12 minutes to present findings to the judging committee (judging criteria will be shared at the opening ceremony).
- Senior Resources of Guilford will own the rights to all deliverables created during the competition.
- All data provided should only be used for analysis purpose of the Data Dive 2024 competition. All data should be deleted from any personal device by 11:59 p.m. ET on Nov. 2.
